### CYCLING : Mavic Service Course for 2009

In 1972 Bruno Gormand gave up his Mavic car to a stricken team manager during that year's Dauphine Libere and the idea for Mavic Service Course was born. Since then they have become a fixture of professional cycling recognised by every fan of the sport.

Since 1985 the yellow shirted brigade of Mavic technicians have provided support at cyclo-sportive events all over the globe, free of labour charge to entrants and will add a truly professional peloton support element to the Dragon Ride Wales.

The 6th Dragon Ride Wales will once again start and finish at Pencoed College, Bridgend and will this year include a futher 12km of tough outbound route towards the Brecon Beacons.
